**2. Updates from the Commissioner & Exec Board**

- a. Sport-centric meetings (DT) - There was general pushback for increased workloads and increased opportunity expression for non-constructive discontentment by people who otherwise have the equal opportunity to attend currently standing meetings

**4. Sport Discussions**

- a. No Refund Policy (JM) - Discussion began questioning the necessity of our standing refund policy. When requested, there are often reason to go ahead and waive despite players having agreed to the no-refund policy. There was question of whether it matter financially or if it is often just used to deter. A suggested was made to transfer all funds that would otherwise be refunded due to cancellations to BARS's philanthropic efforts.
- b. Team randomization, buckets (JM) - Discussion started around the need for standardizing procedures of team randomization and the various groupings of players that have historically been used to balance overall team skill levels. Further discussion was tabled for a following meeting as no registrations for sports that require balancing are forthcoming.
- c. Waitlists (JM) - Discussion began with questioning the possibility of balancing waitlists to promote overall gender diversity for the league. The point was raised that a player replacing another player should be of the same skill level. The counterpoint was also raised that new players should be given the same opportunity to prove themselves of being valuable team and community members. The ethics of supporting our greater LGBT community over the respect of chronological order of signup entered into the discussion as well. In order to promote a more diverse community, it was suggested that other benefits could be extended to waitlisted gender minority persons, perhaps offsetting preference to a later season.
- d. Dodgeball Jumping/Highballs/Face shots (DP)
  - i. Hitting in the face when fully standing doesn't necessarily matter because a

- player in action doesn't ever stand upright.
      - ii. Highball rule encourages people to keep control of their balls
      - iii. Next actionable steps: Is there desire to reword the highball rule?

## **PROPOSAL a.)**

### Revised rules for kickball for seasons with 30 minute games

#### 1. Games

##### *a. Games will last 5 innings or 30 minutes.*

- i. In the event of a tie score at the end of the game, the game shall be marked as a tie.
- ii. If the Home team already leads the game when the bottom of the final inning is reached, that team wins the game instantly and the game is over. If the Home team takes the lead during the bottom of the final inning, that team wins instantly and the game is over.

##### *b. A game that is unfinished after 30 minutes*

- i. If the game is currently in the top of the inning, the game shall end immediately and the score at the end of the last full inning will be the final score.
- ii. If the game is currently in the bottom of the inning, the game will end when that inning is completed or if the Home team takes the lead.

#### 2. Cancelled Games

A game that is called off by the Referee after three (3) full innings of play shall be considered a regulation game. The game score at the end of the last full inning shall determine the winner.

- a. A game that is called off by the referee for any reason before three (3) full innings of play shall not be considered a regulation game and a new game may be rescheduled.

#### 3. Mercy Rules

- a. If a team scores 7 runs in an inning that half inning will immediately come to an end and that team can't score any more than 7 runs in an inning.

#### 4. Forfeits

- a. *If a team doesn't have at least seven (7) players 5 minutes after a game is supposed to start, that team forfeits.*
- b. The team that doesn't forfeit will get 7 runs and the team that does forfeit gets 0 runs.

Copa Figures

- Based on a minimum guarantee of 300 patrons we will be charged \$8,000 for Bar Guarantee. (I got her down from \$15,000) - **if we meet our 8K guarantee in sales we will get our \$4k deposit back in 7 to 10 business days.**
- Plus: \$500 AV tech (equip/microphone) and \$500 for Security – \$1,000 total (n the non-refundable)
- **\$5,000 total deposit**
- We must supply our own DJ
- Rooms will be decorated in Halloween spooky theme

Deposit consists of whatever amount we decide from the \$8K. **Deposit must be in cash only.** If paid by check there will be a NYC 8.75% sales tax.

**Added:** 50 Well drink tickets (for the first 50 guests) @ \$12/tickets = \$600 (plus 8.75% NYC Sales Tax). This is **not** counted towards the \$8K Guarantee.
