1. Sport discussions and sport proposals

- a. Bowling
 - i. Fall 2019 went well overall, feedback survey results will be compiled
- b. Dodgeball
 - i. Fall 2019 Dodgeball - Post Season Survey Results - AY
 - 1. General satisfaction overall
 - 2. A recurring theme included wanting more pizza; majority of respondents would favor increasing registration fees for more pizza
 - 3. The timing of games received several mentions, people wish to have lower wait times. The theme has been explored previously which made it less and less possible to juggle. Knowing what is going on behind the scenes and reasoning behind decisions is good content to include in weekly newsletters
 - 4. Social aspects - there is no way to police social chair activity (or lack thereof), but an effort can be made to ensure each team has a chair and they all have the opportunity to connect.
 - 5. Inclusivity - mentions of cliques and different player demographics. This appears to be perhaps a symptom of a larger situation. We could look into seeing what other LGBTQ+ organizations do to bridge gaps.
 - 6. Scores are asked to be more prompt.
 - 7. Weekly emails receive positive feedback
 - 8. Open Play is offered to be more instructive and the league reports favorable outlook to creating something along the lines of a dodgeball clinic to work on skills. A trial run could be run pre season to gauge interest, perhaps on a monthly basis. A more formal structure will be put together.
 - 9. To ensure fair playtime is 100% guaranteed, there are other methods that may or may not be advantageous
