Proposal 16-6-1: Seasonal Social Media Marketing Budget. Request a seasonal budget of up to \$100 per sport per season for social media marketing, promotion, and outreach and \$50 a quarter for discretionary social media promotion (BARS meetings, POTW, etc.) (See Below) (AV)

Stats from recent Facebook Kickball recruitment campaign:

Saturday Kickball Campaign #1. \$46.68 spent. Paid Reach: 3648 (impressions). 223 actions. 84 photo clicks. 79 link clicks. 45 post likes, 7 comments. 6 shares. CPE (Cost per engagement): ~\$.21 cents. CPA (cost per link click): ~\$.59 cents. *No way to know if those clicks turned in to registrations, but if even one did, ad has paid for itself.

Targeting: Male and Female. NYC Area. people who like your page and their friends. Effective targeting, but fewer degrees of separation.

Run Dates: ~May 24th- June 2nd.

Saturday Kickball Campaign #2. \$20.00 spent. 2255 paid reach. 17 link clicks. CPA: \$1.18. Targeting: males 18-30. Located in NYC Area (Brooklyn, Queens, LIC, Manhattan). Interested in Rupaul, Lady Gaga, Drag Race, Beyonce, etc. Refine targeting. Reaches newer folks outside of regular circles. But less effective targeting.

Proposal 16-6-2: Kickball Rules

- Tagging Up: A runner may tag up once a fielder makes contact with the ball.
 (waka). (AV) *This is encompassed in ii.*
- ii. Proposal: If a Kickball rule is not defined by BARS rules, refs will follow rules outlined by WAKA. (AV) Yay 10, Nay 0, Abstain 3. Motion passes.
